Andrology/Gynecology/Pediatrics of AIDS

The 2nd International Congress will take place in Key West, Florida on December 12-14, 1988. University of Miami School of Medicine and the World Federation of Contraception/Health are cosponsoring 25 invited experts for plenary sessions dealing with: molecular andrology; microbe adherence/computer image analysis; biochemical/biophysical parameters; semen immunology/antibodies; monocytes/macrophages/lymphocytes in semen/immune responses in women; semen banks/IVF clinics; cryopreservation; precautions at IVF clinics; lab personnel/physicians; infant aspiration; HIV genome/activation; lymphokines; interleukin/interferon; heterosexual transmission; risk factors/cofactors/enhancing factors; STDs; contraceptive/HIV; condom dermatitis; IUD/contact dermatitis; colon-rectum anatomy/anomalies; gastrointestinal disorders; condoms/spermicides; placental transmission/immunopathogenesis; immunotropism; perinatal testing; alcohol abuse as cofactor; neopterin; dementia; CNS; neoplasia/cerebrospinal fluid; seroconversion/monoclonal antibodies, and animal models. Several Minisymposia will deal with Neurologic AIDS, Oral AIDS, Kaposi sarcoma/ARC, STD, and AIDS Radiology and Biotechnology. Abstracts/Poster Session are accepted until September 1988. Graduate/Postdoctoral Student Award Reproductive and Developmental Toxicology Subsection Society of Toxicology

We announce our intention to make three awards of recognition for the best platform and/or poster presentations by either graduate students or postdoctoral fellows in the areas of reproductive and developmental toxicology at the 1989 Annual Meeting of the Society of Toxicology in Atlanta, Georgia, to be held February 27 through March 3. Approximate areas of research include male and female reproductive toxicology, reproductive endocrinology, teratology/developmental toxicology, and postnatal functional assessment. Candidates for these awards are requested to send a copy of the abstracts submitted to the Society to the address listed below by November 15.

Abstracts or posters should describe original research which may include applied studies, investigations of mechanisms involved in toxic response, and studies on basic biochemical, physiological, and/or genetic mechanisms of action. Interested individuals may request Society information and abstract forms from the address given below. Preliminary evaluation by a committee of scientists from the Reproductive and Developmental Toxicology Subsection may lead to a formal request for a draft document to be submitted by February 1, which describes the salient features of the research in greater detail. All submitted documents will be treated as privileged information. The successful candidates will be announced at the Annual Meeting of the Specialty Subsection.
